Should the lake become unfishable due to ice, the match(es) will be re-arranged.

Fees

The fee is £20 per match, which consists of a peg fee of £6 with the remaining £14 going into the pools. Details of match and league payouts are detailed overleaf.

Format

Points will be accumulated by section points—1 point for a section win, 2 for second, etc. to a maximum of 5, if you weigh in. Failure to weigh in accrues 6 points and a 'no show' 8 points. This format is designed to allow anglers with a couple of bad results the chance to be able to still compete for a league prize. The league positions will be determined by lowest points scored, if draws occur—by section wins and then by weight. With less than 10 anglers there will be only one section, 10 to 14 anglers two sections, 15 to 19 anglers three sections, 20 to 24 anglers four sections, etc. You will be allowed to drop your worst result. Details of current league positions, previous match results and current league pots will be available at each match.

Rules, Bait Bans, etc.

- A minimum of TWO keepnets must be used – one for carp and the other for silvers. No more than 60lb per keepnet.
- NO boilies, except for hookbait.
- NO high oil pellets to be used.
- NO floating hook or feed baits.
- Barbless hook only.
- Any disputes must be brought to the match organiser's attention as soon as possible. A league committee, consisting of 3 volunteers, will determine any rule changes or breaches in order that a fair and impartial decision can be made.
- ALL litter must be cleared from your peg.
- If you draw the scales (upto two sets will be used) it is expected you will fulfil the duty. Each scalesman will be accompanied by a recorder, again selected by the draw.
